Water Maintenance and Repairs

Spring is a great time to check for leaks and do regular preventative maintenance on your faucets, toilets, water softeners, etc. This can end up saving you lots of water and money. Be a waterwise resident and save water by doing proper maintenance and conserve water by installing water efficient toilets, shower heads etc.

Hose Bib Leaks

Snow and ice are coming down from residents' roofs. This has some unintentional consequences such as causing water leaks. Snow chunks from roofs melting have hit resident's hose bibs. Please check to make sure your hose bib is turned off tight and not causing any dripping or leaking.
