RESOLUTION 2024-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF DURANGO WEST METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 2 ESTABLISHING A BAN ON OPEN BURNING WITHIN THE DISTRICT.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Durango West Metropolitan District 2 (the "District") is a Colorado Special District organized pursuant to the Colorado Special District Act, C.R.S. § 32-1-101, et seq. (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the District owns, operates and maintains a water supply and distribution system (the "District Water System) which provides water for domestic use and fire protection; and

WHEREAS, the District owns and maintains certain properties in the District which are designated or dedicated on plats as Greenbelts, Out Lots or Golf Course (collectively called "Greenbelts"); and

WHEREAS, wildland fire poses a significant threat to residential areas which could exceed to available resources to control or extinguish; and

WHEREAS, the residential area within the District and the Greenbelts are forested and are susceptible to the rapid spread of wildland fire; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the District has previously determined that the Southwest is experiencing a long-term climate trend toward drought conditions which increase the likelihood of wildland fire within the District; and

WHEREAS, a wildland fire within the District would threaten the Greenbelts and would rapidly deplete available water reserves of the District when substantial amounts of water would be needed for fire suppression; and

WHEREAS, District allocates a significant portion of its General Funds to fire mitigation in the Greenbelts to reduce the potential for wildland fire; and

WHEREAS, the potential for wildland fire within the District can also be significantly reduced with reasonable restrictions on open burning; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the restrictions adopted herein are necessary to protect the District Greenbelts and preserve a safe, adequate and reliable water supply for its residents and for fire protection.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Durango West Metropolitan District No. 2:

- 1. <u>Open Burning Prohibited</u>. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, stove fire, burn barrel or trash fire within the boundaries of the Durango West Metropolitan District No. 2 is prohibited.
- **2.** Exceptions. The prohibition on open burning does not apply to grilling or cooking food using appliances on their property designed for cooking or grilling and can be turned off or covered.
 - 3. **Enforcement**. If a violation of the open burning prohibition occurs, the following charges shall be

imposed:

- i. First violation after warning: \$100.00
- ii. Second violation after warning: \$200.00
- iii. Third and all additional violations after warning: \$300.00

All unpaid charges shall constitute a perpetual lien against the property until paid as provided by the Colorado Special District Act.

- **4. <u>Burn Permits.</u>** This resolution shall be furnished to the Durango Fire Protection District with a request that burn permits not be issued within the District.
- **5.** <u>Prescribed Burns</u>. A prescribed burn within the Greenbelts to reduce the threat of wildland fire may be allowed by the Board with a prescription to meet planned fire or land management. A "prescription" means a written plan establishing the criteria necessary for starting, controlling, and extinguishing a burn.
- **6.** <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution revision shall be effective immediately upon its adoption and approval.
